Debtors agree that this note is provided not in payment of, but as additional security for and evidence of obligations due to the Seller under existing Agreements with Debtor and this note is not accepted in lieu of Seller's mechanic's lien, payment bond, trust fund or other legal rights. Debtors expressly agrees to submit to personal jurisdiction in Virginia and agrees that the forum for any litigation pursuant to this Agreement or any other contract between Seller and Debtor, whether suit is brought by Seller or Debtor, shall be the County of Fairfax, Virginia. This Note shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Virginia.

Debtor hereby constitutes and appoints James D. Fullerton, Kavita Knowles, John Purdy, Turkessa Rollins, Richard Hutson or any other attorney in the law firm of Fullerton & Knowles, P.C. or any successor law firm, his true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with full power and authority hereby given him to appear and present this note before the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Fairfax County, Virginia, at any time after maturity or default on any of the installments hereof and to waive the issuance and service of process and to confess judgment against him in favor of the payee or holder hereof for the amount of money due plus interest and costs, plus attorney's fees in an amount equal to 33% of the amount of money due, less credit for payments made.
